To schedule an appointment, click [here](#) (Book Now zocdoc button) and select the state you reside in for telehealth. It's quick, simple, and easy, follow these steps:

1. Fill out **patient forms/consents** and provide the requested personal information. Submit payment, if necessary, prior to visit.
2. **“Arrive early”** for your appointment by logging in to your Patient Portal, either on your computer or through the [zocdoc](#) app on your smart phone. If you can't access the Portal, you can also begin your appointment by clicking the reminder link sent to you via email/text.
3. Click **“Join Video Visit”** in your patient dashboard
4. Click **“Proceed”** to check your computer's speed and ability to support a TeleHealth appointment. If you are using your computer, instead of a smart phone, your computer will need a webcam (most have one).
5. Your physician will begin the face-to-face TeleHealth visit and disconnect when the visit ends.
